

**Tripartite appeal
of the Chairmen of the Lower Silesian Regional Assembly,
the Supreme Council of the Autonomous Republic of Adjara,
the Brandenburg State Parliament
on the sovereignty and territorial cohesion of Ukraine and Georgia**

since the end of World War II, Europe had enjoyed an unprecedented and longest period of peace and development in history. A period which, since 2008, has been systematically undermined and destroyed by the actions of the Russian Federation. The events of 2008 and 2014 will forever remain in the minds of Europeans as those that resulted in the criminal and unprovoked attack of the Russian Federation on Ukraine on February 24, 2022. After 30 years, the Ukrainian people must again fight for their rights and territorial cohesion, which shows how fragile peace in Europe is.

We, the Chairman of the Lower Silesian Regional Assembly, the Supreme Council of the Autonomous Republic of Adjara and the Brandenburg State Parliament, on behalf of the local and regional communities we represent, strongly condemn the actions of the Russian Federation and call for international unity, support for fighting Ukraine and support for restoring the integrity and territorial cohesion of Georgia.

We consider any military action on the territory of sovereign and independent states unacceptable. We oppose actions aimed at depriving nations which have chosen the path of freedom and democracy of the possibility of self-determination. We view the attacks carried out by the Russian Federation against the civilian population and critical infrastructure of Ukraine disgraceful.

In the face of violations of international law and armed aggression, we hereby emphasize that every free and independent state and its inhabitants have the right to security, peace and self-determination.

We hereby express our solidarity with the Ukrainian people and reaffirm our will to help. We pay tribute to the victims of the armed conflict and the Ukrainians who died in the fight for their homeland.

We appeal to the state authorities and the international community to maintain support for the Ukrainian and Georgian people and their pro-European aspirations.





**Joint statement
about the cooperation between
the Landtag of Brandenburg,
the Sejmik of the Lower Silesian Voivodeship and
the Supreme Council of the Autonomous Republic of Adjara**

Following the "Joint Declaration of Intent on Cooperation between the Land of Brandenburg and the Lower Silesian Voivodeship" of 24 October 2016 and the "Agreement on Cooperation between the Supreme Council of the Autonomous Republic of Adjara and the Landtag Brandenburg" of 6. December 2018, the members of the Landtag Brandenburg, the Sejmik of the Lower Silesian Voivodeship and the Supreme Council of the Autonomous Republic of Adjara aim to intensify their already existing long-standing cooperation between the representations and to promote initiatives that serve the further development of cooperation.

At their trilateral meeting in Potsdam on 18 March 2023, the signatory parties agreed to strengthen contacts at the level of parliamentary bodies and to promote the exchange of experience and information on issues of cooperation in the fields of Open Government, in particular on measures from the areas of citizen participation and transparency, the economy, environmental protection and nature conservation as well as culture and sports, and to strengthen this through regular meetings and visits by regional politicians.
